

2016 PROPOSED BUDGET MEETING
THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2015

The public hearing on the Town of Round Lake 2016 proposed budget was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairperson Sanders. Present were Supervisors: Wilson, Karns, Schara, and Hanson. Also present were Clerk McCoy, Fire Chief Schmidt, and 5 audience members (all being town residence). Total town residents including board, clerk and fire chief (12).

Budget was presented by Clerk McCoy: A brief overview of budget and reserve accounts was provided by Clerk, (noting a town levy decrease of \$5,483.00 or 1.62% for 2016). Decrease due to elimination of Debt Payment in 2016.

Audience had no questions or comments on 2016 proposed budget.

Hearing adjourned at 6:38 p.m.

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF ROUND LAKE, SAWYER COUNTY, THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2015.

Chairperson Sanders called the meeting to order at 6:39 p.m. The same electors present at the budget hearing attended the town elector meeting.

- 1.) To approve the total highway expenditures for 2016 pursuant to Sec. 82.03 of Wis. Statutes. Motion by Kay Wilson, seconded by Rolfe Hanson to approve 2016 highway expenditures as presented in proposed budget. Motion carried
- 2.) To set compensation of elected town officials for the term of office beginning April 2016 through April 2018 pursuant to Section 60.10 (1) (b) of Wis. Statutes. Motion by Jane Bidwell that elected officials wage amount remain the same (Hanson and Schara Supervisor Seats - \$463.68) along with continued provision of an annual increase in wages each year based on/ equal to the Consumer Price Index (CPI) increase used by Social Security. Second by Mark Rosenow. Motion carried 12 in favor, 0 opposed.
- 3.) To adopt the 2015 town tax levy to be paid in 2016 pursuant to Section 60.10 (1) (a) of Wisconsin Statutes. Motion by Kay Wilson, seconded by Marilyn Karns, to adopt the 2015 town levy of \$ 333,117.00 to be paid in 2016. Motion carried.
- 4.) Motion to adjourn at 6:47 p.m. by; Jane Bidwell: seconded by Charlotte Reder. Motion carried.
