Glass Jars and Bottles

Plastic Milk Jugs

Plastic Bottles - #1-#7

No Food Waste, Garbage, or Yard Waste

No Food Tainted Items - used paper plates, paper towels, or paper napkins

No Pizza Boxes

No Egg Cartons

No Ice Cream Cartons

No Paper/Waxy Milk Cartons

No Aluminum Foil

No Plastic Cups and Silverware

No Aerosol Cans

No Plastics other than *Numbered*1-7

No Juice Boxes/Bags

No Automotive Product Bottles
