

FIREWORKS

Just a reminder...



Possessing or using fireworks that explode or leave the ground without a valid permit is illegal. The sale of these restricted fireworks to a resident of Wisconsin without a valid permit is also illegal.*

Restricted fireworks include:

- Firecrackers
- Roman Candles
- Bottle Rockets
- Mortars

Wisconsin does allow (without a permit) the sale, possession and use of:

- Sparklers not exceeding 36 inches in length.
- Stationary cones and fountains, toy snakes, smoke bombs, caps and noisemakers.
- Confetti poppers with less than ¼ grain of explosive mixture.
- Novelty devices that spin or move on the ground.

Please be conscientious about when and where you display permitted fireworks.

- Avoid setting them off over water or within heavily forested areas.
- Be respectful of the time of day, your neighbors and wildlife.
