Motion by Sandra Schara that the salaries for the two supervisor positions (\$500.86) remain the same (subject to Cost of Living Increase each year): Second by Kathy McCoy. Motion carried with all 11 electors voting in favor.

Motion by Sandy Schara to adopt the 2021 town tax levy in the amount of \$365,000.00 to be paid in 2022: Second by Sharon Haak. Motion carried unanimously.
