**REFERRING DRAFT AMENDMENT OF NON-METALLIC MINING LICENSING
ORDINANCE NO. 2022-04 TO THE TOWN OF ROUND LAKE PLAN COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Town of Round Lake Board enacted Non-Metallic Mining Licensing Ordinance No. 2022-04 on June 9, 2022;

WHEREAS, Notice of the Town Board's enactment of Ordinance No. 2022-04 was published in the Sawyer County Record on July 6, 2022 in accordance with applicable legal requirements and Ordinance No. 2022-04 became effective on July 7, 2022;

WHEREAS, the Town Board is in receipt of a draft ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 2022-04, § 9(2)(b) and increase the setback requirements contained therein to 3000 feet; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Round Lake Plan Commission Ordinance authorizes the Town Board to adopt a resolution referring any matter the Town Board deems advisable to the Town Plan Commission for report within 30 days;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Town of Round Lake Board hereby refers the draft amendment to Ordinance No. 2022-04 to the Town Plan Commission for report within 30 days.

**AMENDMENT TO TOWN OF ROUND LAKE NON-METALLIC MINING LICENSING
ORDINANCE NO. 2022-04.**

The Town of Round Lake, Sawyer County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Amendment

Section 9(2)(b) of the Town of Round Lake Non-metallic Mining Licensing Ordinance No. 2022-04 is hereby amended to read:

- (b) A minimum setback of ~~2000~~3000 feet from the edge of the property boundary on which the mining operation is located to a residence is required. However, the setback does not apply (i) to a residence that is occupied by someone who has sold or leased their land to the applicant on which the mining facility will be located nor (ii) to a residence that is occupied by someone who has leased lands for a mining operation, though not covered by the license application under current review.

Section 2. Effective Date

Following passage by the Town Board, this Ordinance shall take effect the day after the date of publication or posting as provided by Wis. Stat. § 60.80.
