

The Town of Round Lake, in conjunction with its design consultant Northern Wisconsin-Based Engineers, Inc., is planning an improvement project on Moose Lake Road from County Road A to Federal Forest Road 320. The primary purpose of the project is to replace the deteriorating pavement structure on the roadway. Construction is currently scheduled for the summer of 2027.

Proposed improvements include the following:

- Pulverize 6 inches of the existing pavement with 2 inches of added base and relay as a foundation layer for new pavement
- Overlay the pulverized layer with 4 inches of new hot mix asphaltic pavement
- Replace one 12-inch diameter corrugated steel culvert pipe with an 18-inch diameter corrugated steel culvert pipe

The project will include a short-term detour of Moose Lake Road during culvert replacement and pulverize and relay operations. The detour route will be County Road A to County Road B to County Road S. Temporary access to properties along Moose Lake Road will be maintained at all times. No new right-of-way will be required for the project.

A Public Involvement Meeting for the project is scheduled for Thursday February 12, 2026 from 5:30-6:30 PM at the town hall located at 10625N County Road A. A short presentation is scheduled to begin at 5:45 PM. The remainder of the meeting will be an open house. The regular monthly town board meeting will follow at 6:30 PM.
