 - a. Review and discussion of proposed Junk Ordinance regulating the accumulation and storage of junk, junk vehicles, appliances, and related materials within the Town of Round Lake, including proposed enforcement procedures, notice requirements, abatement provisions, forfeitures, and Agricultural zoning exemptions
 - b. Review and discussion of legal guidance and statutory authority relating to public nuisance ordinances, junked vehicles, highway encroachments, property rights considerations, and enforcement limitations under Wisconsin law, including Wis. Stat. §§ 175.25, 823, 86.04, and related provisions
 - c. Consideration of recommendations, modification, postponement, or other direction regarding the proposed ordinance and future ordinance development process
- 4) **Adjournment** - The Regular Town Board Meeting will commence at 6:30 p.m. or immediately following the conclusion of this meeting, whichever occurs later.

Discussion and possible action may occur on items specifically noticed as such.

Note: It is possible that members of, and possibly a quorum of, other decision-making bodies of the Town of Round Lake — such as the Land Use Planning Commission (LUPC), Plan Commission, or other committees and commissions — may be present at this meeting to gather information about subjects over which they may have decision-making responsibility.

Such presence may constitute a meeting of those other bodies pursuant to *State ex rel. Badke v. Greendale Village Board*, 173 Wis. 2d 553 (1993). No action will be taken by any body other than the Town Board at this meeting, and no action will be taken except as specifically noticed on the agenda.
