ORDINANCE NO. 7903 (10)

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE WATER TRAFFIC, BOATING, AND WATER SPORTS UPON THE WATERS OF A PORTION OF THE WEST FORK OF THE CHIPPEWA RIVER AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Board of Supervisors of the Town of Round Lake, Sawyer County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: INTENT

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public needs and the capability of the water resource.

SECTION 2: APPLICABILITY

The provisions of this ordinace shall apply to the waters of the West Fork of the Chippewa River within the jurisdiction of the Town of Round Lake.

SECTION 3: ADDITION - TRAFFIC RULES

In addition to the traffic rules in Wi. Statute 30.65 adopted in SECTION 1 of this ordinance, the following rules shall apply to water craft using waters covered by this ordinance.

A. No person shall operate any water craft contrary to any legally placed bouys.

SECTION 4: REGULATORY MARKERS

Bouys will be placed to provide the public with the provisions of this Section as follows:

- A. Attached to permanent anchor located about 100 feet upstream of the Dam on the north shore of the West Fork of the Chippewa River, thence about 480 feet sought across the river to a permanent anchor located approximately 100 feet upstream of the Dam on the opposite side of the river. Placement as indicated on attached map.
- B. Standard Marks. All markers so placed will be in compliance with regulations of the Department of Natural Resources.
- C. Interference with Marker Prohibited. No person shall without authority remove, damage, destroy, moor or attach any water craft to any bouy, beacon 9or marker placed in the waters of the river by the authority of the United States, State, County, Town, Village or by any private person pursuant to the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5: ENFORCEMENT

- A. The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by any officer of the Sawyer County Sheriff's Department or State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, any board member, authorized employee or authorized representative of the Town of Round Lake, Sawyer County, Wisconsin.
- B. The Town of Round Lake, by adoption of this ordinance hereby elects to use the citation method for enforcement of this ordinance.
- C. Any person who shall violate any provisions of this ordinance whall upon conviction, forfeit not more than \$50. for the first offense, and shall forfeit not more than \$100. upon

conviction of the same offense a secon	d or subsequent time within one year.
SECTION 6: WISCONSIN STATUTES DEFINED. Whenever used in this ordinance, the term "Wisconsin Statutes" shall mean the Wisconsin Statutes of 1959 and subsequent amendments.
